




Chelsea

Once home to the historic Meatpacking District, this colorful neighborhood long since evolved into a major art, shopping, and lifestyle destination with a wide array of galleries and boutiques. It's also quickly becoming known as the East Coast home of tech giant Google and coworking pioneer WeWork. Take a stroll on the High Line for views of the Hudson and the cluster of lively new buildings that nestle its path, including the Renzo Piano-designed Whitney Museum.

The High Line is New York City's only elevated park and one of Manhattan's most popular attractions.

Along with his wife, Kristen, and chef John Doherty, interior designer Mark Zeff merged the worlds of food, home decor, and lifestyle into one place with the 2017 opening of their Blackbarn Shop, Café and Bar in Chelsea Market. "The vibrant neighborhood, which is quickly becoming the epicenter of a quadriad of west-side neighborhoods, seemed like the perfect fit for this concept store—and we found a great partner with Chelsea Market," says Zeff. In a sense, he's come full circle as his eponymous firm was located here in the early 2000s, and he now visits



Blackbarn at Chelsea Market thrice weekly. His local recommendations, aside from **Blackbarn** of course, include **Mantiques Modern**, one of his favorites for collecting one-of-a-kind design objects, **Cookshop** for lunch, and the bar at **Hotel Americano** for drinks. And, while the High Line has largely been the Chelsea attraction for the last decade, Zeff adds, "The new **Whitney Museum** is a quintessential experience."


